LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT





Welcome to the 2021-2022 Season of the Saginaw Bay Symphony Orchestra! We are very happy to be "Bringing Music to Life" back in the beautiful Temple Theatre and once again celebrating live musical performances with you, our season subscribers.

This season's performances were developed to bring the community together to share in the joy of live symphonic music. Our season opens on October 16th with "The Best of John Williams" - sure to be a crowd-pleaser. Williams has been

composing soundtracks for movies for over 50 years and this concert will feature such favorites as Hook, Schindler's List, Star Wars, and more. The SBSO will usher in the holiday season with our annual Holiday Pops - Saginaw Sings concert on November 30th. The Orchestra will be joined on stage by the Saginaw Choral Society, the Saginaw Bay Youth Orchestra, the Saginaw Youth Choir, and Saginaw's own Todd Michael Hall, recently featured on NBC's "The Voice." What better way to welcome the holidays than featuring the talents of so many members of the Saginaw Bay community! In April, the SBSO will team up with Pit and Balcony as well as the Saginaw Valley State University Concert Choir to present a semi-staged production of Peter Schaffer's play Amadeus featuring the music of Mozart. Other concerts will feature an original piece, "KRUPA," composed by our Music Director, Maestro Fakhouri, and the music of the enigmatic Shostakovich.

The Saginaw Bay Symphony Orchestra is an organization that enriches the community through the beauty and power of symphonic music. We strive to enhance the vitality of our region and contribute to economic and cultural growth. In good times and in challenging times, the SBSO is committed to fulfilling this mission. Not many cities the size of Saginaw can support a symphony orchestra and we are grateful for the ongoing support of this community. To give back to those who have supported us, we have been very active even during the pandemic. Over the last 18 months, we hosted numerous free "pop-up" mini-concerts in Saginaw and Bay City, surprising and delighting people with short musical performances. We have continued to support the Saginaw Bay Youth Orchestra to instill the love of symphonic music in the next generation of musicians. We were among the first to return to the stage last May when we eagerly presented limited in-person concerts for the Orchestra and the youth orchestra. Most recently, the SBSO performed a spectacular free pops concert for an appreciative crowd of around 2,000 people at Wenonah Park in Bay City!

These have been difficult times for all of us and the SBSO needs your financial support more than ever. About 25% of our operating revenue comes from ticket sales. With no live concerts since February 2020, ticket revenue has plummeted. Thank you for your support this season through your ticket purchases. We also rely on donations to support our performances. PROFILE

MUSIC DIRECTOR



Born in Beirut, Lebanon, Fouad Fakhouri hails from a musical family whose roots go back four generations. He holds a Doctor of Musical Arts in Composition from the University of North Texas, and a Master of Music in Orchestral Conducting, as well as a Master of Music in Composition/Theory from the Pennsylvania State University. He earned his Bachelor of Music in Theory and Composition from West Texas A & M University.

With over two decades of international credits as a conductor and composer, Fakhouri is committed to actively engaging with audiences through powerful artistic experiences. Known for his "musical accuracy" and "emotional intensity," his performances have been celebrated for their broad, dynamic, and powerful interpretations, which go beyond the score to capture both the essence and spirit of the music. In June 2016, after a year and a half long international search, Fakhouri was named Music Director of the Saginaw Bay Symphony Orchestra in Michigan. From 2004 - 2016 Fakhouri served as Music Director and Conductor of the Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra (North Carolina). In 2009 he was appointed Principal Guest Conductor of the Greensboro Symphony Orchestra (North Carolina) and was also Music Director and Conductor of the Greensboro Symphony Youth Orchestra where he led the orchestra on its first international tour to Austria and Germany.



Among his many recent international guestconducting appearances are the Lebanese Philharmonic Orchestra (Lebanon), Symphony Orchestra (Egypt), and the Bulgarian Symphony Orchestra (Sophia, Bulgaria). In addition to conducting, Fakhouri is an active composer of a multitude of symphonic, chamber, choral, and solo music. His works have been premiered and performed by the English Chamber Orchestra (UK), the Bulgarian Symphony Orchestra, the Mediterranean Orchestra (Italy), and the Philadelphia Youth Orchestra to name a few.

In December 2014 in recognition of "his impressive career achievements, phenomenal leadership of the Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra (FSO), and dedication to music and the community" Methodist University (NC) bestowed upon him an Honorary Doctorate of Humane Letters. In March 2016 he was inducted into the Fayetteville (NC) Music Hall of Fame and in April 2016, upon the completion of a highly successful 11-season tenure with the FSO, individual donors honored him with establishing "The Fouad K. Fakhouri Endowment for Artistic Excellence" - a \$1.1 million fund. Fakhouri resides in New York City with his wife Diane Lavelle, an advertising executive, and their daughter Isabella.
